

SUMMER 2021 DESCRIPTIONS

“INTERMISSION-LUNCH” (Add-on) \$9/day



Families who would like their children to engage in mealtime with friends may pack lunch to enjoy in the shady picnic-table area. (PA5678 will not supply food or drink. Food and drink must be supplied by child’s guardian.) *This is a great option for working parents, or anyone who would enjoy this change of pace!*

BROADWAY JAZZ This class for 9th - 12th Graders includes stretches and work across the floor, and center. In each class, students will learn a quickly taught Jazz Routine, engaging in a mock-audition. This class sharpens retention and performance skills, learning at a quick pace. JUNE 22, June 29, July 6, July 13. (Tuesdays 2:45pm - 3:45pm).

ADVANCED TAP This advanced class for 9th - 12th Graders, students progress with terminology fluidity, technique, form, counting, keeping time with music, syncopated rhythms, and various styles. Mini Routines will be taught during each class. JUNE 22, June 29, July 6, July 13. (Tuesdays 3:45pm - 4:30pm).

BALLET/TAP Emphasizing coordination through movement, class includes Ballet warm-ups, stretches, and work across the floor while learning proper terminology, technique, and how to keep time with music. In Tap, students learn rhythm, timing, and terminology. Families are invited to observe a mini-performance during the last 10 minutes of the final class.

“DAD-Y” (Dance, Act, & Draw for Youngsters) Children are engaged, interacting with other children! Beginning with party-type dance (ie: YMCA, Twist, etc...), kids get up and move, learning dance movement indicative of light-hearted fun dances. With an age appropriate approach to acting, participants have fun listening to a story,

discussing the emotions of the characters, and acting out those emotions. Each class culminates with a mini-drawing tutorial, based on the story of the day.

MUSICAL THEATRE (*Lion King*, *Snow White*, *Annie & Moana*) Does your child like to perform? This class incorporates Acting, Singing, and Choreography, putting together an abbreviated performance to be performed on the last day for Family and Friends. In addition to the performance material, Team-Building Exercises and Acting Improvisational Games bring classmates together in a structured, fun atmosphere.

SNOW WHITE: JUNE 28 - JULY 2 1-st - 4th Graders (Monday - Friday, 5 days) 9:00am - 12:00pm (This session will include Acting/Musical Theatre/ Ballet/ Tap to put on a performance that is “Snow White” themed on the last day incorporating all styles)

ANNIE: JULY 6 - JULY 16 2nd - 6th Graders (Mondays - Fridays, 9 days) 9:00am - 11:45am

MOANA: AUGUST 9 - 13 4-6 Year Olds (Monday - Friday, 5 days) 10:45am - 11:30am

ACTING SCENE WORK In this Acting Class, participants engage in Team-Building Exercises and Acting Games, building a fun, creative atmosphere. Actors will work on Scene work, developing retention skills, exploring emotional journeys, and fostering creativity. Actors perform in a final showcase for Family and Friends during the last class. JULY 6 - JULY 16 (Monday - Friday) 2nd - 6th Graders 12:15pm - 2:00pm

ACTING IMPROVISATION WORKSHOP (7th - 12th Graders) In this ensemble-based Class, Actors are fully engaged, exploring various acting games, activities, and improvisational work. Participants develop focus, think fast on their feet, and have fun being truly creative. JULY 6 - JULY 9 (Tuesday - Friday, 4 days) 6:30pm - 7:30pm

MUSICAL THEATRE (*HONK JR.*) Adapted for young performers, and with a score by George Stiles and Anthony Drewe (*Mary Poppins*), *Honk! JR.* is a heartwarming celebration of being different that is sure to delight with its sparkling wit, unique charm and memorable score. Witty and hilarious, but also deeply moving, this musical entertains with equal amounts of laughter and tears. Participants are invited to an informational day (August 5th), in which scripts will be distributed, a read-through, audition information will be given, and audition music cuts will be reviewed. Auditions will take place on August 9th, followed by rehearsals. Performances for family and friends on August 26th (3:00pm and 6:30pm). Two instructors: Jessica Lombardi (Director/Choreographer) and Courtney Hirschey (Musical Director.) Please Note: Due to the nature of putting on a full show, there will be times performers are divided up into groups, working both on the outdoor stage area as well as inside the studio, allowing one group to work on music while another works on staging and/or choreography.
